### FOURTH SUNDAY OF ADVENT, YEAR A 21ST DECEMBER, 2025

#### Theme: Emmanuel: God with us

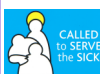
### **TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS IF VISITING ST. ERCONWALD'S**
