
love he invites us to have for each other: deep, tender, lasting, not afraid of showing itself. Let us ask Jesus for such a compassionate and committed love.

NEW LECTIONARY

The new edition of the Lectionary for Mass, approved by the Bishops' Conferences of England and Wales and of Scotland, will be published in October, and mandated for use from 1st December 2024 [1st Sunday of Advent, Year C]. From that date no other English edition of the Lectionary for Mass may be used in these countries - the ones we currently use in Church cannot be used anymore. Now in four volumes, the Lectionary uses the English Standard Version – Catholic Edition of the Bible with psalm texts taken from Abbey
