THEME: With Jesus in the Storm



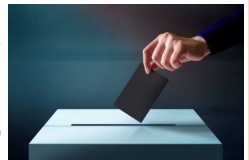
"Where are you, Lord, when we suffer?" "Why do you sleep, Lord, when your Church is in pain?" "Why is there so much evil in the world?" These are often our cries when we feel threatened by the waves of misfortune and suffering and evil. And the Lord's answer to us is a question: "Why are you so afraid? I am with you! Have faith in me, trust me." In the Eucharist we express our trust that with the Lord we can overcome all evil and trials.

MEDITATE: This story [Mark 4. 35-41] is not only about Jesus' power over the wind and sea; it is about Jesus presence *during* the storm.

ACT: Try to be a calming presence to someone you know who may be experiencing some turbulence in his or her life right now.

GENERAL ELECTION – 4th JULY

The opportunity to vote in a general election is a privilege. As politicians will be looking for our votes, we have a responsibility as Catholics to use our vote to make sure that parties commit to tackling important issues. A theme that Cardinal Vincent would like us to reflect on is: *How do we seek to construct a society in which families can flourish?*
